(just south of Vickers Way)

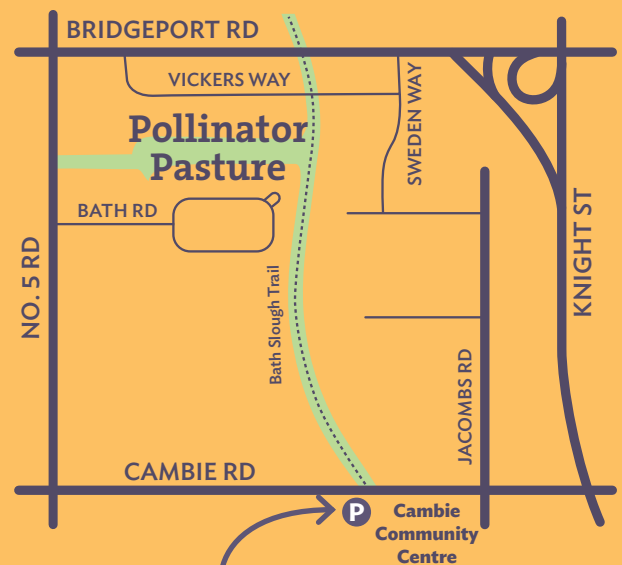
